

GENERAL INFORMATION - HOLIDAYS IN TENERIFE

1. General distance rule

Furthermore, a minimum distance of 1.5m to third parties should be maintained. This applies in all closed rooms, Titsa-bus and also outside.

If this distance cannot be maintained, a mask must be worn.

2. Shopping

When shopping, it is compulsory to wear a mask and the shops have disinfectant gel or gloves available. Card payment is recommended but not mandatory.

3. Restaurant

There is no longer a capacity limit for gastronomic facilities, but the minimum distance between the tables/table groups of 1.5m must be observed. Shared menus will no longer exist, alternative methods will be used, e.g. via QR code.

At the table there is no mask obligation for guests!

If somebody leave the table, new guests may only sit down after it has been cleaned and disinfected.

4. Accommodation

The basic principle is that the specific safety measures of each facility must be observed.

Buffets, for example, only have single plates, often disposable napkins/table cloths, food is handed out by hotel staff, ...

5. Beach

The special municipal regulations apply, whereby a distance of 1.5 metres is mandatory. Sport is only allowed individually or in pairs, whereby contact of any kind is prohibited. Sunbeds or hammocks must be disinfected after use. A minimum distance of two metres applies.

For this reason, masks are not required on the beach.

6. Nightlife

Nightlife is allowed outdoors and at tables with a maximum capacity of 75 percent, while avoiding crowds. Accordingly, the dance floors remain closed.

7. Events

Are basically allowed outside up to 1000 persons (300 in closed rooms) with staggered access and adherence to the distances.

However, many communities have already cancelled the traditional fiestas by the end of the year.

8. Airport

On arrival and departure, temperature measurements are taken and masks are required.
